





- Monitor boys' progress closely


Prefects







Why do you need a Parents Association?

BWS is an Academy School and achieves excellence through Pupil and Staff hard work and supported by the BWS Network, BWS Foundation and Old Wordsworthians to name a few.

It costs close to £6M per annum to run the School; we receive just over £5.5M from public sources; the remainder comes from donations and hire of facilities".


