- 1. What choices do you make? How do you decide? Give two examples (4 marks)
- 2. Give an example of a choice a firm made. Why did they do this? Quote your source. (5 marks)
- 3. Find a newspaper article about a choice the UK government has made. Explain it briefly (a few sentences). Hand in the article with your explanation or quote your source. (5 marks)
- 4. Go on to the Bishop Wordsworth School website. Select "Curriculum" at the top of the page and then "Economics". At the top of this page you should select "Student Resources" and then "Year 12". Have a look at this page and then answer the following questions:
 - a. How many folders are there?
 - b. What is the date of the AS Economics A Accredited specification? (open up the file to check)

c. Why is the 5th folder important? (3 marks)
