



## CODICIL

**If you have an existing will but would like to include a gift to Bishop Wordsworth's Grammar School, you can do so by adding a codicil.** The wording provided below serves as a helpful starting point for you to discuss with a solicitor.

*"In addition to any legacies given in my will, I give Bishop Wordsworth's Grammar School the sum of £..... or .....% share of my residuary estate to be used in line with the School's need at the time. In all other respects I confirm my will and any other codicils to it."*

Once you have completed your codicil, you will have it witnessed by two people who are not related to you or to any person mentioned in your will, just like the full will and testament.

You will need to store the codicil with your will.

Example wording:
